Practice basic addition skills with fun word problems using real-life situations and simple numbers.

$$12 + 8 = 20 \text{ oranges}$$

Sam has 15 stickers. His friend gives him 7 more stickers. How many stickers does Sam have now?

$$15 + 7 = 22 \text{ stickers}$$

A classroom has 14 boys and 13 girls. How many students are there in the classroom?

$$14 + 13 = 27 \text{ students}$$

There are 20 balloons at a party. The children bring 15 more balloons. How many balloons are there now?

$$20 + 15 = 35 \text{ balloons}$$
