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Answer Key

Practice basic addition skills with fun word problems using real-life situations and simple numbers.

Mia has 18 crayons. She buys 12 more crayons. How many crayons does she have altogether?

$$18 + 12 = 30 \text{ crayons}$$

A farmer has 25 chickens. He buys 14 more chickens. How many chickens does he have now?

$$25 + 14 = 39 \text{ chickens}$$

A library has 12 books. The school adds 8 more books. How many books are there now?

$$12 + 8 = 20 \text{ books}$$

A bakery made 15 cupcakes in the morning and 10 more cupcakes in the afternoon. How many cupcakes did they make in total?

$$15 + 10 = 25 \text{ cupcakes}$$



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
