Ella picked 45 strawberries from the farm. She picked 32 more strawberries. How many strawberries did she pick?



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Answer Key

Practice two-digit addition with engaging word problems that help students build problem-solving skills.



Aiden has 24 apples. His mom gives him 35 more apples. How many apples does Aiden have now?

$$24 + 35 = 59 \text{ apples}$$

Chloe baked 42 cookies. She baked 27 more cookies later. How many cookies did Chloe make in total?

$$42 + 27 = 69 \text{ cookies}$$

Mason bought 36 cupcakes for a party. His dad bought 28 more cupcakes. How many cupcakes do they have altogether?

$$36 + 28 = 64 \text{ cupcakes}$$

Ella picked 45 strawberries from the farm. She picked 32 more strawberries. How many strawberries did she pick?

$$45 + 32 = 77 \text{ strawberries}$$
