Practice two-digit addition with engaging word problems that help students build problem-solving skills.

Sunflowers can turn their faces toward the sun.



Amelia baked 29 muffins in the morning and 33 more muffins in the evening. How many muffins did she bake in total?

$$29 + 33 = 62 \text{ muffins}$$

Benjamin has 56 candies. His sister gives him 21 more candies. How many candies does he have now?

$$56 + 21 = 77 \text{ candies}$$

Scarlett collected 47 peaches from the garden. She collected 36 more peaches later. How many peaches does she have?

$$47 + 36 = 83 \text{ peaches}$$

Daniel bought 38 pizzas for a party. His friend brings 44 more pizzas. How many pizzas are there altogether?

$$38 + 44 = 82 \text{ pizzas}$$
