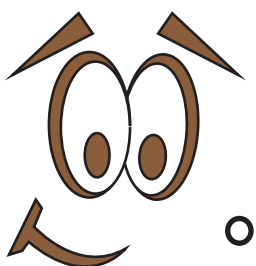

- 2) A school has 475 students in the morning shift and 326 students in the afternoon shift. How many students are there in total?

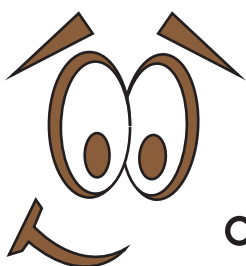
$$\underline{475 + 326 = 801 \text{ students}}$$

$$\underline{268 + 457 = 725 \text{ items}}$$
