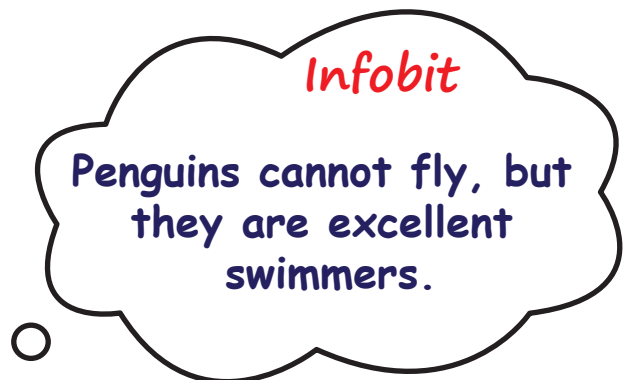
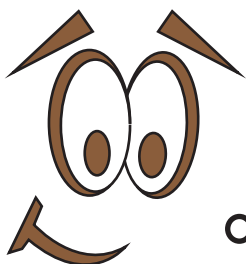

- 2) A factory made 675 toys in one week and 248 toys in the next week. How many toys did it make altogether?

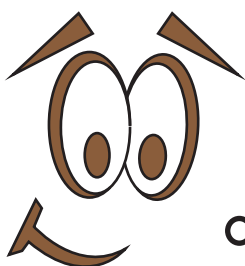
$$\underline{675 + 248 = 923 \text{ toys}}$$

- 3) A bakery prepared 438 cakes and 356 cookies for an event. How many food items were prepared?

$$\underline{438 + 356 = 794 \text{ items}}$$

- 4) A charity collected 529 blankets and 274 clothes for donation. How many items did they collect in total?

$$\underline{529 + 274 = 803 \text{ items}}$$
