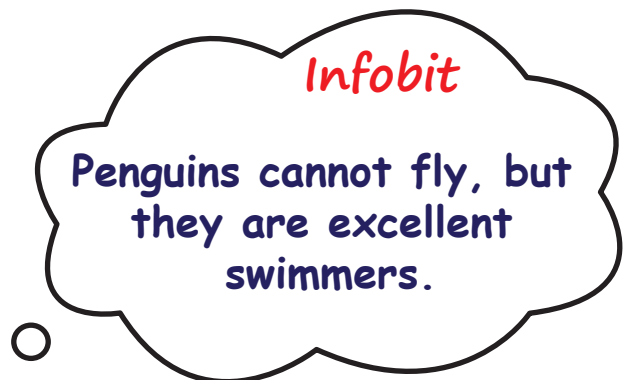
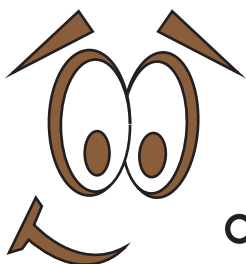

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Answer Key

$$\underline{642 + 358 = 1000 \text{ items}}$$

- 2) A farmer has 487 chickens and 265 ducks on his farm. How many birds does he have altogether?

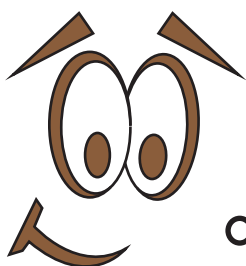
$$\underline{487 + 265 = 752 \text{ birds}}$$

- 3) A shop sold 356 bottles of juice and 429 bottles of water. How many drinks were sold in total?

$$\underline{356 + 429 = 785 \text{ drinks}}$$

- 4) A company printed 734 flyers for one product and 186 flyers for another product. How many flyers did they print altogether?

$$\underline{734 + 186 = 920 \text{ flyers}}$$
