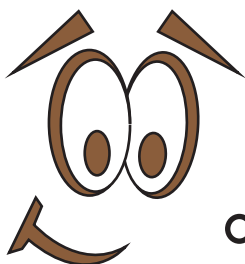

Answer Key

$$\underline{24,568 + 18,745 = 43,313 \text{ people}}$$

- 2) A library has 35,760 fiction books and 28,945 non-fiction books. How many books are there altogether?

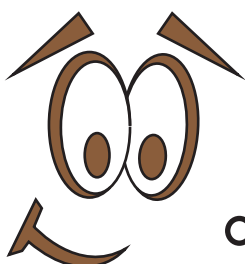
$$\underline{35,760 + 28,945 = 64,705 \text{ books}}$$

- 3) A factory produced 46,825 toys in January and 37,650 toys in February. How many toys did the factory produce in total?

$$\underline{46,825 + 37,650 = 84,475 \text{ toys}}$$

- 4) A farmer harvested 56,430 apples and 42,875 oranges. How many fruits did the farmer harvest altogether?

$$\underline{56,430 + 42,875 = 99,305 \text{ fruits}}$$



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
