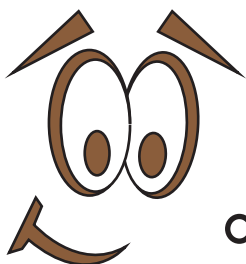

$$\underline{38,750 + 26,450 = 65,200 \text{ dollars}}$$

- 2) A company shipped 75,640 packages in one month and 48,325 packages the next month. How many packages were shipped altogether?

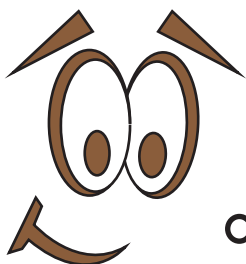
$$\underline{75,640 + 48,325 = 123,965 \text{ packages}}$$

- 3) A museum had 86,750 visitors in summer and 64,890 visitors in winter. How many visitors came in total?

$$\underline{86,750 + 64,890 = 151,640 \text{ visitors}}$$

- 4) A bookstore sold 95,625 books in one year and 78,450 books the next year. How many books were sold altogether?

$$\underline{95,625 + 78,450 = 174,075 \text{ books}}$$



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
